2.ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

Eligibility for admission is as specified by the University of Kerala for admission to each Programme.

Nativity: Candidate should be an Indian citizen. Candidates seeking admission to PG courses will be categorized as Keralite and Non-Keralite.

Keralite: A candidate of Kerala origin will be categorized as a Keralite. Children of All India Service Officers allotted to Kerala Cadre are deemed to be Keralites as per G.O. (Rt) No.822/08/H.Edn Dated 09/05/2008. But they will not be eligible for communal/special reservation.

Non-Keralite: A candidate who does not come under Keralite category will be categorized as Non- Keralite. Such a candidate will be eligible for admission only after all the applicants of Keralite origin are ranked and allotted.

In order to prove that a candidate is an Indian citizen of Kerala origin for the limited purpose of eligibility for admission, he/she has to produce any one of the following certificates.

In the case of candidates who have undergone College studies in Kerala, a Course Certificate from the Head of the educational institution last attended in Kerala, certifying that the candidate has undergone his/her studies in Kerala for not less than 3 (three) years with in a continuous period of 12 (twelve) years, immediately prior to the completion of the Bachelor's Degree or equivalent examination.

OR

A certificate from the Village Officer/ Tahsildar to show that he/she or his/her mother/father was born in Kerala OR Certificate from the Village Officer/Tahsildar to the effect that the candidate has been a resident of Kerala State for a period of five years within a continuous period of twelve years.

OR

The true copy of relevant page of Secondary School Leaving Certificate showing the Place of Birth in Kerala of the candidate.

OR

The true copy of the relevant page of the Secondary School Leaving Certificate showing Place of Birth in Kerala of either of the parents of the candidate with corroborative certificate to establish the relationship between the parent and the candidate.

OR

The true copy of the relevant page of the Passport issued by the Government of India of the candidate, showing Place of Birth in Kerala or of either of the parents of the candidate showing Place of Birth in Kerala with corroborative certificate to establish the relationship between the parent and the candidate. Non-Keralites should furnish a copy of the Certificate of nativity from the revenue authority or local body concerned.

Academic Eligibility

a. M.Sc. Computer Science

an equivalent Degree recognized by the University of Kerala for the purpose

- (ii) Any Science degree with minimum three years duration after 10+2 with not less than 5 CCPA[S] out of 10 with Computer Science/Computer Application as one of the main/subsidiary/core subject or an equivalent Degree recognized by the University of Kerala for the purpose.

Graduates in CBCSS Pattern (Prior to 2013 admission)

- (i) *A Degree course with minimum three years duration after 10+2 with not less than 2 CGPA[S] out of 4 in Computer Science/Computer Application/Electronics /Mathematics / Statistics/ B Voc Data Science as main or an equivalent Degree recognized by the University of Kerala for the purpose.*
- (ii) *Any Science degree with minimum three years duration after 10+2 with not less than 2 CGPA[S] out of 4 with Computer Science/Computer Application as one of the main/subsidiary/core subject or an equivalent Degree recognized by the University of Kerala for the purpose.*

Graduates in Annual Scheme / Other Pattern

NOTE

1. Candidates whose degree "is accepted as equivalent there to by the University of Kerala" are alone eligible to apply.
2. CCPA(S) is CCPA for specialized subjects (it is computed without considering the Language Courses, Foundation Course for Language and Open Course).
3. All grades will be converted into Percentage of marks for preparation of rank list.
4. For Scheduled Caste/ Scheduled Tribe Category: The requirement is a pass in the Qualifying Examination with minimum CGPA(S) of 1.5(CBCS Prior to 2013 admissions)/CCPA(S) of 4 (CBCS 2013admissions) for CBCSS Pattern of study and The minimum mark in the qualifying examination for PGDegreecourseofstudyis35%forannualSchemeofStudy.
5. For SEBC category, a relaxation of 2% and for persons with disability that of 5%is allowed for the minimum requirement of Educational qualification.

3. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

(a).University Quota

50% which includes all reservation quota seats will be filled up through Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) by the University of Kerala. For more information please refer University CAP website <http://www.admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in>

The rank list for PG Degree courses will be prepared on the basis of marks/CGPA obtained in the qualifying examination in Part III Subjects / Core and Complimentary Courses, (including weightage/deduction where ever applicable), unless otherwise mentioned. The rank list will be prepared based on the total marks/Percentage of CGPA (converted by the formula provided by respective University) obtained by the candidate out of 1000 (for more information please refer the clause 6 of Prospectus for CAP **2024** of the University of Kerala at admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in)

(b). IHRD Quota

Remaining 50% seats will be filled up by the colleges as Institution quota based on merit. Candidates who wish to apply for the same have to submit duly filled up application online to the College where they desire admission. Website: www.ihrdadmissions.org

PREPARATION OF RANKLIST:

The rank list for PG Degree Programmes will be prepared on the basis of marks/CGPA/CCPA obtained in the qualifying examination in Part III Subjects/Core and Complimentary Courses, (including weightage/deduction wherever applicable), unless otherwise mentioned. The rank list will be prepared based on the total marks/Percentage of CGPA (CBCS Prior to 2013 admissions)/ CCPA (CBCS 2013 admissions onwards) (converted by the formula provided by respective University) obtained by the candidate out of 1000.

M.Com

Graduates in CBCSS Pattern (2013 Admission onwards) - Candidates qualified in CBCS pattern will be ranked on the basis of the CCPA obtained in the Core and Complementary Courses. $A = \{ (CCPA \text{ (core course)} \times \text{Core course Credit}) + (CCPA \text{ (Complementary course)} \times \text{Complementary course Credit}) \} / (\text{Total Credit for core} + \text{Total Credit for complementary})$ $B = A \times 10$ B is then normalized to 1000.

- (i) Graduates in CBCSS Pattern (Prior to 2013 Admission) Candidates qualified in CBCS pattern will be ranked on the basis of the CGPA obtained in the Core and Complementary Courses. $A = \{ (CGPA \text{ (core course)} \times \text{Core course Credit}) + (CGPA \text{ (Complementary course)} \times \text{Complementary course Credit}) \} / (\text{Total Credit for core} + \text{Total Credit for complementary})$ $B = A \times 25$ B is then normalized to 1000

- (ii) Graduates in Annual Scheme/Other Pattern - The internal marks awarded at the B.Com level will not be considered while calculating index marks. NOTE: In case of the candidates who have passed the Vocational/ Restructured the marks scored in the University Examination (2nd, 4th and 6th semesters) alone will be considered for ranking purpose

M.Sc. Programme

- (i) Graduates in CBCSS Pattern (2013 Admission onwards) - The candidates will be ranked on the basis of the CCPA(S) plus the CCPA of the core ie $A = \{(\text{CCPA}(S) \times \text{Total Credits}) + (\text{CCPA of Concerned Core Course} \times \text{Credit of Concerned Core Course})\} / (\text{Total Credits} + \text{Credit of concerned core course})$ $B = A \times 10$ (*symbol for multiplication) B is then normalized to 1000.
- (ii) Graduates in CBCSS Pattern (Prior to 2013 Admission) - The candidates will be ranked on the basis of the CGPA(S)* plus the CGPA of the core ie $A = \{(\text{CGPA}(S) \times \text{Total Credits}) + (\text{CGPA of Concerned Core Course} \times \text{Credit of Concerned Core Course})\} / (\text{Total Credits} + \text{Credit of concerned core course})$ $B = A \times 25$ (*symbol for multiplication) B is then normalized to 1000.
- (iii) Graduates in Annual Scheme/Other Pattern - The candidates will be ranked on the basis of total marks obtained for the optional subjects plus the marks obtained in the Optional Main subject. $\{\text{Part III Total Marks (Out of 1000)} + \text{Marks obtained in concerned Main (Out of 600)} / 1600\} \times 1000$ In the case of candidates who have qualified under three main systems the marks obtained in the three main plus the marks obtained in the main concerned will be used for ranking.

WEIGHTAGE/ DEDUCTION OF MARKS:

- a. **Weightage of Marks** : Five (5) marks each for certificate holders of National Service Scheme [NSS]/ National Cadet Corps [NCC] for participation in NSS/NCC at the Degree level. Weightage marks may be added to the marks scored by the candidate either to make him eligible for admission to a course of study or for ranking purposes to those who are otherwise eligible for admission . In the case of candidates who get this eligibility by this bonus marks, their ranking mark will be the sum of scored marks and the bonus marks.

NOTE

- (i) In respect of candidates who want to avail bonus marks for NCC, the marks will be awarded on the basis of NCC Weightage Certificates signed by the Director and issued by the Directorate of NCC to the candidates who have secured at least 75% of attendance after having participated in its activities during the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.
 - (ii) In respect of candidates who want to avail bonus marks for NSS, the marks will be awarded on the basis of NSS Certificates signed by the Vice-Chancellor and issued by the University to volunteers who have completed 240 hours of work within a period of two years in the course of study immediately preceding the course for which admission is sought.
 - (iii) The benefit of bonus marks for purpose of admission can be availed by the candidates only under any one category (either NCC or NSS).
- b. Deduction / Loosing of marks for subsequent appearances:* Candidates will lose 10 marks for ranking purposes from the total ranking marks for each additional appearance he/she has taken for completing the qualifying examination.

Note: Number of chances means the number of chances for passing any part of the qualifying examination excluding cancellation.

RESOLVING OF TIE:

In the case of more than one candidate obtaining equal index marks (Including weightage/ deduction as per Clause 7.4, if applicable), the candidate who has scored more marks in Part III Main will be placed higher in ranking. If the tie persists, the candidate who has scored more marks in Part I / Part II English will be placed higher in ranking. In the case of ranking for M. A. English, the conditions in clause 7.1.1 will be applicable.

If the tie still persists, the age of the candidates will be taken into account, the older being placed higher in the ranking. Even after this exercise, if the tie persists the alphabetical order of the first name of the candidates will be taken into account.

The Candidates should produce the following documents in original at the time of interview for admission.

- a) Matriculation Certificate.
- b) Certificates and Mark list of the qualifying examination.
- c) Community/Income Certificates, if applicable.
- d) TC and Conduct Certificate from the institution last studied.

RESERVATION

All the statutory reservation seats available will be filled up by the University through the Online Centralized Allotment Process (CAP).(for more information please refer the Prospectus for CAP 2024 of the University of Kerala at <http://admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in/pg>

4. HOW TO APPLY

a. Application Online

Application for admission to various degree courses in College of Applied Sciences against IHRD Quota seats is to be completed online through the website of IHRD: www.ihrdadmissions.org. The print out of the online application along with documents is to be submitted to the Principal of concerned colleges at the time of admission. Separate online application should be submitted for seeking admission to different Applied Science Colleges under IHRD.

b. Registration Fee

The Registration fee for applying in a single IHRD college under University of Kerala is Rs.250/- and additional fee at the rate of Rs.100/- each will be charged for candidate applying for more than one college. (Rs.100/-for SC/ST candidates and additional fee at the rate of Rs.50/- each will be charged for candidate applying for more than one college). Application Registration fee payment will be accepted only through **SBI Collect** as per details in the IHRD admission portal. **Application Registration fee once remitted shall not be refunded under any circumstances.** The details of application Registration fee remitted should be entered in the admission portal while submitting the online application. **Applications without application Registration fee will be summarily rejected.**

CANDIDATES SHOULD PAY THE REGISTRATION FEES THROUGH SBI COLLECT ACCOUNT ONLY.

Candidates shall not remit the fee in any other form like Demand Draft, Cheque etc..

c. 4Submission of Application

The print out taken after submitting online application along with supporting documents shall be submitted to the Principal of concerned Applied Science Colleges (Please see para1, for the communication address of the Applied Science Colleges) at the time of admission, if the candidate is selected provisionally in the rank list. Applications will be considered only if he/she has furnished the relevant certificates prescribed in the Prospectus. The candidates who wish to secure admission in the college also need to furnish the CAP registration number in the application form, after completing the online registration procedure provided in the admission portal of University of Kerala. (<http://www.admissions.keralauniversity.ac.in>)

**. In addition, the student will have to remit the University affiliation / administration and other fees as required by the University from time to time, including examination and Camp Valuation fee.*

ii. The PTA fee as recommended by the College concerned has to be remitted at the time of admission.

Fee concession / Caution Deposit details

- All students are required to pay Caution Deposit irrelevant of category including SC/ST/OEC candidates.
- No educational concession will be available to the students of the PG Degree programs conducted in the Colleges of Applied Sciences under IHRD except the SC/ST/OEC candidates. The SC/ST/OEC candidates are exempted from payment of the prescribed fee on condition that they will submit application for educational concession to the SC/ST Development Department in the prescribed form along with supporting documents within 15 days from the date of admission. If they fail to do so, they should pay the prescribed fees. In case, the educational concession is not sanctioned by the SC development department, the student is liable to remit the entire fee. Sanctioning of educational concessions is also subject to the orders of SC Development Department/ Government from time to time.
- All students including those eligible for any type of Educational Concession from various Departments/Welfare Agencies, except the SC/ST/OEC Category, should remit the entire fee as per the schedule. But the actual amount sanctioned towards the educational concession to the eligible students by the Department/ Welfare agencies will be reimbursed to them by the Principal, as and when it is received in the institution.

6. RULES FOR ISSUE OF TRANSFER CERTIFICATE

- a) Any student who gets admission to PG programs later discontinues his/her study from any one of the College of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, TC will be issued as per conditions specified in the G.O.(MS)no. 319/2017/H.Edn.(J) dated 29-12-2017.ie. In the event of a student withdrawing before the starting of the Course, the entire fee collected from the student, after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs.1, 000/- (Rupees One thousand only) will be refunded by the College. If a student leave after joining the Course (date of commencement of classes) and if the vacated seat is consequently filled by another student by the last date of admission, the College will refund the fee collected after a deduction of the processing fee of Rs.1000/- (Rupees One thousand only) and proportionate deductions of monthly fee and proportionate hostel rent, where applicable. In case the vacated seat is not filled, the candidate is eligible to get refund of the Caution deposit only. All such refund will be processed only after closure of PG admission 2024-25 by the University. Fee for the candidates getting admission in any of the College of Applied Science, managed by IHRD, during the same admission year will be adjusted after deducting the admission fee.
- b) If a student applies for TC to join Higher Option allotted by Centralized Allotment Process (CAP) for the PG admission of the University, the TC and other documents will be issued as per the University guidelines in time to time.
- c) In case of Inter College transfer between CAS under IHRD within the same University and program after the date of closure of admission, TC will be issued on payment of Rs.2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand Only) towards processing fee. In such cases, the applicant is eligible to get refund of 75% of the tuition fee only through inter institutional transfer.

The rules 7a, b & c given above is applicable for all students admitted, including those admitted through Centralized Admission Process of University.

7. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Candidates should appear for Interview/Admission at their own cost.
2. The Candidates should produce the following documents in original at the time of interview for admission. Matriculation Certificate, Marklist & Certificate/Provisional of the Degree examination, Community/Income Certificates, if applicable for SC/ST/OEC candidates.
3. T C and Conduct Certificate from the institution last studied.
4. If any candidate who is provisionally selected for admission fails to report to the Principal on or before the specified date and time or if he/ she fails to pay the fees indicated in the admission memo his/her selection will stand cancelled.
5. Late applications will not be considered under any circumstances.
6. Candidates from Universities other than University of Kerala should produce migration Certificate and pass certificate at the time of interview/admission.
7. The applicant who's qualifying examinations other than a degree of the University of Kerala should submit an eligibility certificate from the University of Kerala at the time of admission.
8. Receipt of application will be acknowledged allotting a register number. The registration number as shown in the receipt should be mentioned in all future correspondence once confirming admission.
9. Selection of Candidates will be made by the Principal as detailed in clause 3. Admission procedure.
The selection for admission will be provisional subject to verification of original documents and eligibility by the Head of the Institution. On verification, if any information given in the application is found to be false, the candidate will forfeit his/her claim for admission.
10. The list of candidates called for interview will be published in the institution. Selection memo will be sent by email only. Hence providing valid email-id and a contact telephone number is mandatory. However, if a student wishes to get memo by ordinary post, he/she must attach a separate request to the Principal along with the application form.
11. The candidates called for interview should bring the originals of all the Certificates on the date specified at their own expense. T C should be produced within a week from the date of provisional admission.
12. A candidate who does not turn up for the interview as per the schedule and at the place and time will forfeit his/her chance for admission and will not be considered for any future vacancies for admission irrespective of the rank secured. However, if a candidate is not able to attend the interview on genuine grounds, the parent/guardian or any authorized person can act as a proxy at the risk of the candidate.
13. The candidate seeking admission to the course will have to abide by the campus rules and regulations issued from time to time. Copy of the campus rules now in force in the institutions under IHRD is available in the office of the Colleges, for reference.

8. RAGGING IS A COGNISABLE OFFENCE AND PUNISHABLE UNDER PROVISIONS OF KERALA PROHIBITION OF RAGGING ACT.1998.

The institution will take stern action against the offenders. The cardinal points contained in the act are furnished below for information of the concerned.

(i) SHORT TITLE AND EXTENT

- a. The Act maybe called the Kerala Prohibition of Ragging Act 1998.
- b. It extends to the whole of the State of Kerala.

(ii) DEFINITION

"Ragging" means display of disorderly conduct, doing any act which causes or is likely to cause physical or psychological harm or raise apprehension or fear or shame or embarrassment to a student in any, educational institution and includes

- a. Teasing, abusing of ,playing practical jokes on or causing hurt to such student; or
- b. Asking the student to do any actor perform something which such student will not in the ordinary course willingly do.

(iii) PROHIBITION OF RAGGING

Ragging within or outside any educational institution is prohibited.

(iv) PENALTY FOR RAGGING

Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or propagates ragging within, or outside, any educational institution, shall, on conviction, be punished with imprisonment for a term which may extent to two years and shall also be liable to a fine which may extend to ten thousand rupees.

(v) DISMISSAL OF STUDENT

Anystudentconvictedofanoffenseundersection4shallalsobedismissedfromtheeducationalinstitution and such student shall not be admitted in any other educational institution for a period of three years from the date of order of such dismissal.

(vi) SUSPENSION OF STUDENT

(a) Whenever any student or, as the case may be, the parent or guardian or a teacher of an educational institution complains, in writing, of ragging to the head of the educational institution, the head of that educational institution shall, without prejudice to the foregoing provisions, within seven days of the receipt of the complaint, enquire into the matter mentioned in the complaint and, if, prima facie, it is found true, suspend the student who is accused of the offence, and shall, immediately, forward the complaint to the police station having jurisdiction over the area in which the educational institution is situated for further action.

(b) Where, on enquiry by the head of the educational institution, it is proved that there is no substance prima facie in the complaint received under sub-section (1), he shall intimate the fact, in writing, to the complainant.

(vii) Copy of the prohibition of Ragging act 1998 will be available in the institution for reference. The applicants as well as his/her parent/guardian are required to furnish declaration on the awareness of the provisions of the Act in the application form.
